

PPG included in 2017 Corporate Equality Index

The Human Rights Campaign included PPG in its 2017 Corporate Equality Index with a rating of 75 percent. The index rates large U.S. employers on a scale of 0 to 100 percent based on whether they meet a range of criteria related to health care coverage of domestic partners, transgender-inclusive benefits, diversity training, organizational competency on LGBT issues and external engagement with the LGBT community.

The Workplace Gender Equality Agency honored PPG ANZ (Australia and New Zealand) with a prestigious “Employer of Choice for Gender Equality in Australia for 2016” citation.
